Complete and submit the Business Damage Assessment Survey

If your business has been impacted by Hurricane Irma, fill out this <u>simple form</u> to help ensure that our area gets the proper state and federal resources, and to expedite disaster relief programs for all businesses.

✓ Report damage to Palm Beach County Business and Industry Unit ESF 18.

All businesses are also asked to immediately assess and report any damage that is a direct result of Hurricane Irma. Send an email regarding your damage to esf18@pbcgov.org for inclusion in the overall reporting of damage to the county, State and Federal agencies.

✓ Florida Small Business Emergency Bridge Loan Program

<u>Short-term, interest-free loans of up to \$25,000</u> are now available to qualified businesses. Applications will be accepted under this program <u>through Oct. 31, 2017</u>, contingent on the availability of funds, for small businesses with two (2) -100 employees established prior to Sept. 4, 2017. Follow these easy steps to begin the application process:

- 1) <u>Register online</u> for free consulting services from the Florida SBDC Network.
- 2) Review criteria and download application at <u>FloridaDisasterLoan.org</u>.

✓ Employees and Residents with Losses

Individuals can register online at <u>www.DisasterAssistance.gov</u> for disaster assistance from FEMA or call 1-800-621-FEMA (3362). The toll-free telephone numbers will operate from 7 a.m. to 11 p.m. EDT seven days a week until further notice.
