### **Downtown District and Neighborhoods**

The walkable Downtown district is comprised of 3.5 square miles, a main street that runs from the interstate to the Atlantic Ocean right through the Downtown. It consists of six unique neighborhoods: West Atlantic – Gateway to Downtown; The Ave – Electric; Pineapple Grove Arts District – Artsy; SOFA (South of Atlantic) – Up & Coming; US1 – Urban; Beachside – Relaxed. All unique in their own character filled with a mix of commercial and residential areas.

### **Annual Visitors:**

Delray Beach has a tradition of welcoming all to the Village by the Sea for over 100 years. As a resort town on the east coast of Florida, it is our goal to attract both visitors, local and seasonal residents to this tropical destination. Annually, Delray Beach will see close to 2 million people on our beach and an additional 2 million who visit our Downtown. Delray Beach is home to many fun festivals and events that showcase our community all attracting estimated averages from 2,000-100,000 people.

#### Location and Accessibility:

Delray Beach is located on the Southeast coast of Florida in southern Palm Beach County. Delray Beach is accessible from Palm Beach International Airport and Ft. Lauderdale International Airport. There is connectivity from commuter rail (Tri-Rail) and highspeed rail known as Brightline. The city provides FREE transportation east and west to and from the station to the downtown main street, Atlantic Avenue which connects to Bus transit north and south.
