


The Delray Beach Downtown Development Authority (DDA) is a taxing authority created by the State of Florida in 1971. The Authority is charged with reinvesting the Ad Valorem property tax - which funds the DDA - back into the downtown, focusing on three key areas to help promote the district, business and property owners: Marketing, Placemaking and Economic Vitality.

The district is comprised of 340 acres east of I-95. The boundaries of the DDA district are Atlantic Avenue east from I-95 to the high tide mark; Swinton Avenue north to NE 4th Street and east to NE 6th Street; Swinton Ave south to SE 2nd Street on the east side and east to SE 6th Ave. The area is a blend of commercial, residential, city and county property.




SAFETY AMBASSADORS

PARKING

Need employee parking options?

Public Parking Garages are free if you arrive prior to 4 p.m. and thereafter a \$5 flat fee from 4 p.m. to midnight Monday through Saturday. Parking is free in public garages on Sundays.

For any City resident, there is a Downtown Parking Permit for \$12 annually. Residents are able to park in public garages, surface lots and certain side streets from 12 p.m. until 6 p.m. for FREE.

Handicap

Handicap parking is FREE up to 4 hours at all public parking spaces, public parking garages and public lots in Downtown Delray Beach. Vehicle must have a proper handicap license plate or placard.
